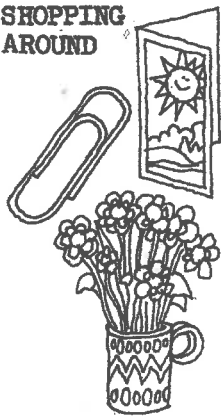

SENN HIGH

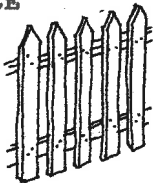
