ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING



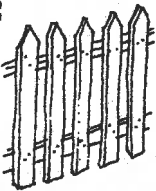

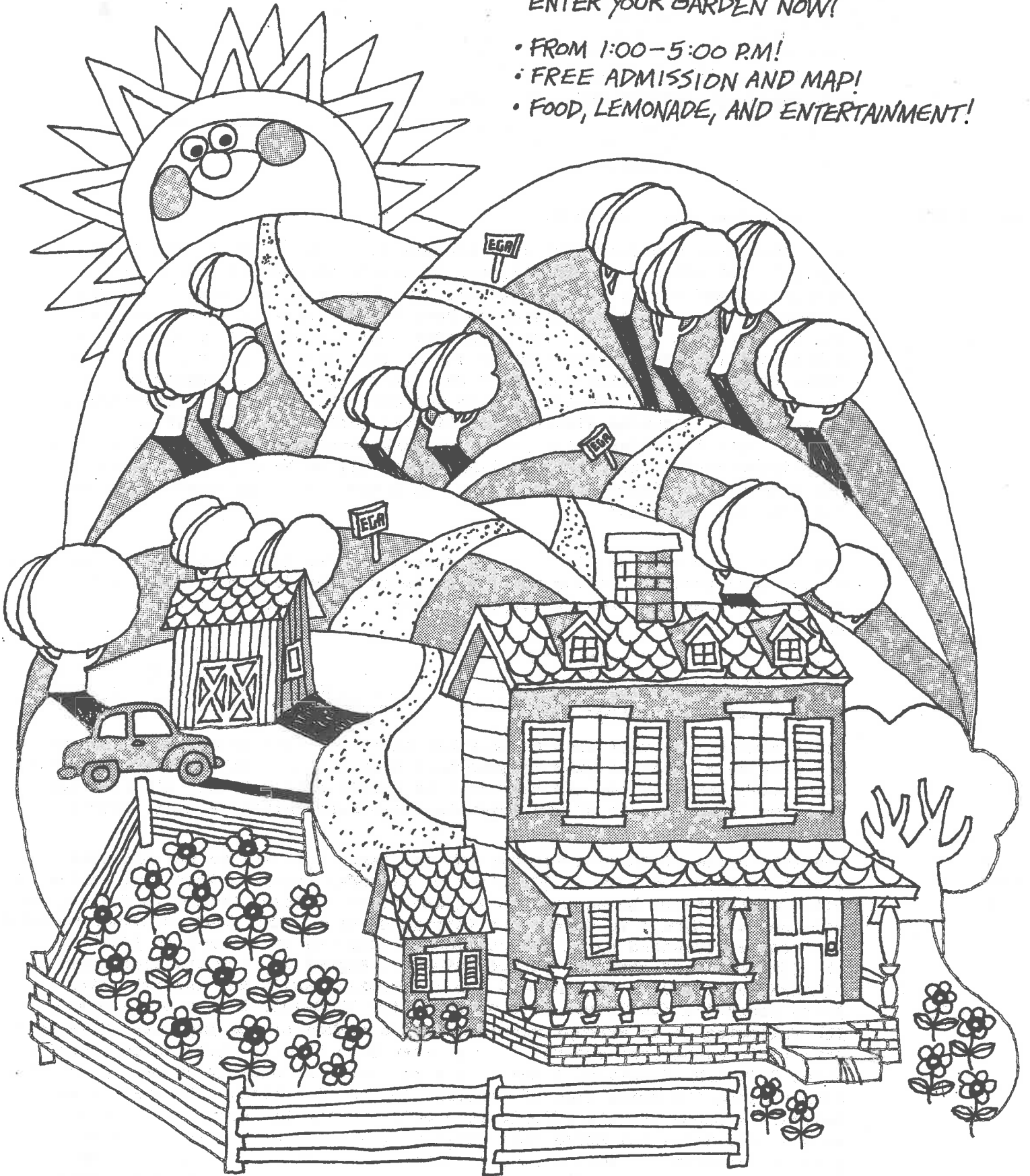
