GENERAL MEETING



On Wednesday, June 20, 1979, the Edgewater Glen Association will hold a General Meeting at a site-to-be-decided. The main topic for the meeting will be a discussion of Utilities and Energy which is decidedly an issue of current interest. The meeting has been scheduled at the suggestion of Mr. Warren Friedman, one of our newer EGA residents; the following is a commentary by Mr. Friedman, urging your attendance at our up-coming general meeting:

UTILITIES AND ENERGY



"Commonwealth Edison is presently asking the Illinois Commerce Commission for its eighth rate hike in nine years. This time they want \$452 Million, an 18.3% increase in their revenues. They want this huge jump in our rates despite the fact that their profits in 1978 were up 30% over 1977. They want this money to build new nuclear plants. These plants are dangerous, expensive, and unnecessary. Last year during the busiest hour (the hour of "peak demand") on their busiest day, 42% of their plant capacity was idle.

"The rate hike can be stopped by pressuring the five commissioners of the I.C.C. to vote no during this rate hike hearing (the hearing starts June 11, 1979). Early in July, the commissioners will decide whether Edison has an emergency need for cash and should get half of the hike without full hearings. Early next year they will decide on the rest.

"EGA should do its part to stop this unjust rate hike."

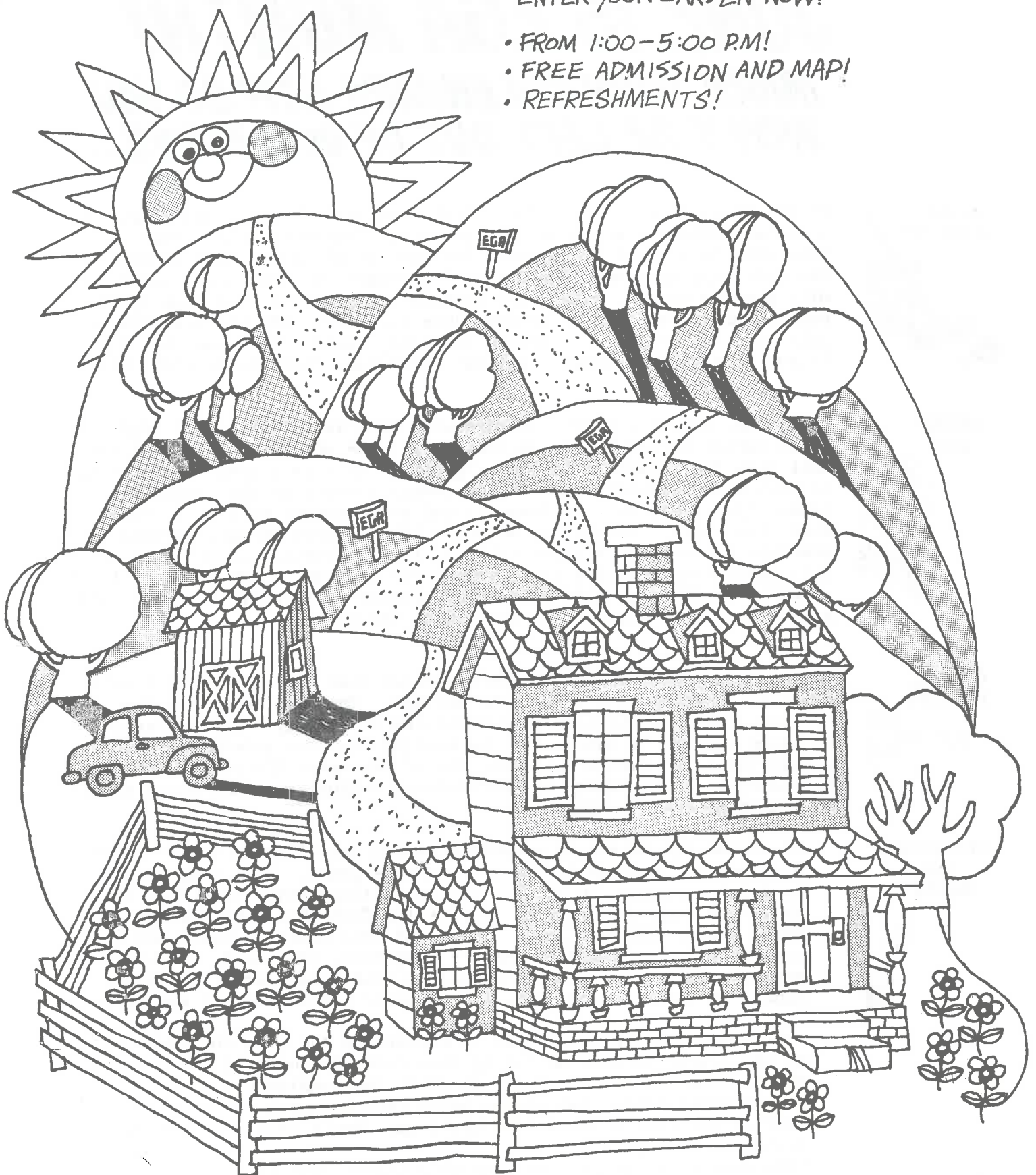
