TREES



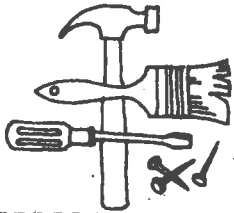

According to the inspectors, none even need rodding out. They simply can't handle the load during a flash storm. The City recommends stand-pipes in the basement drain and pointing downspouts away from your home's foundation.

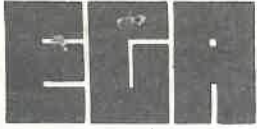

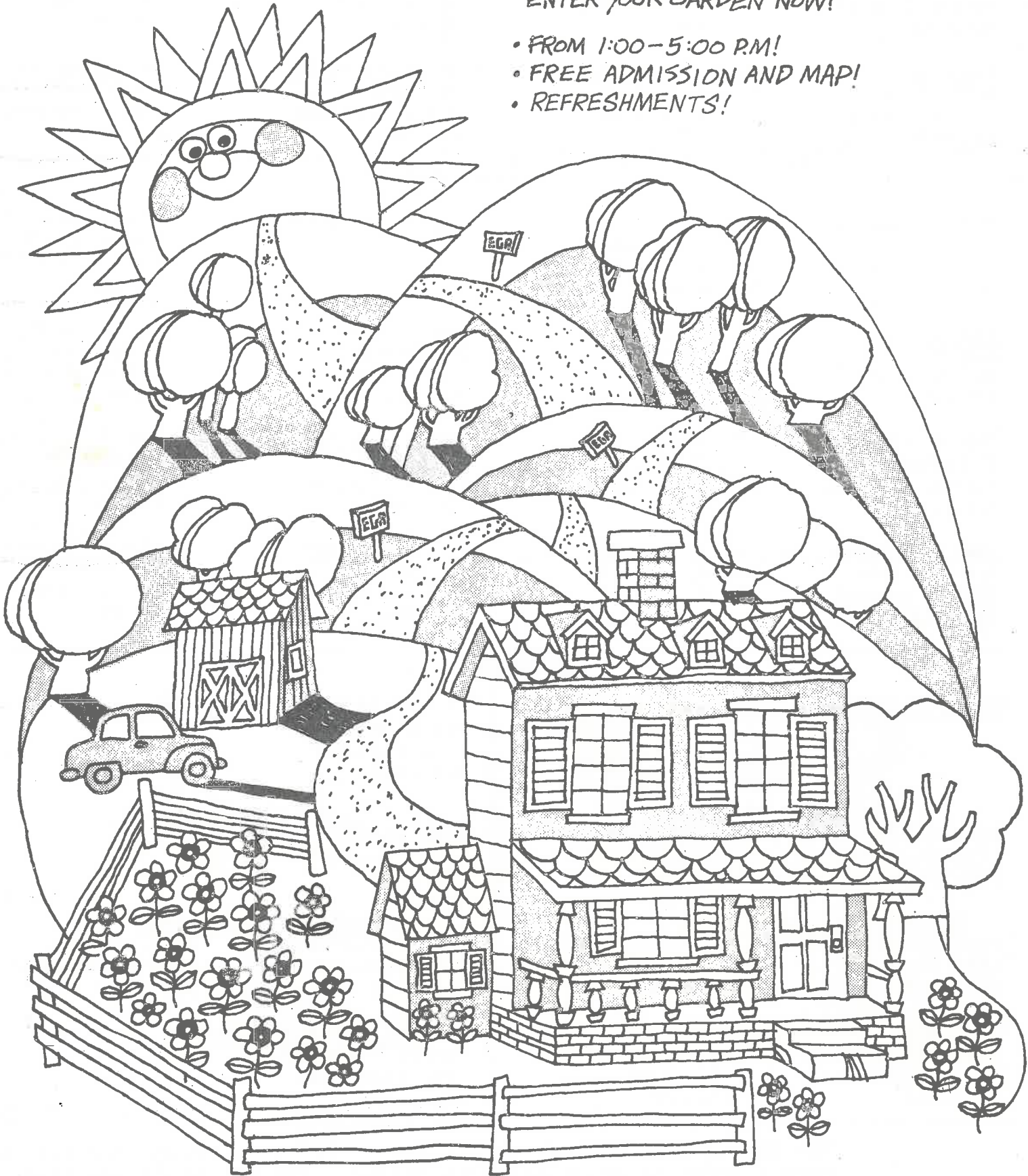
