EGA COMMITTEES



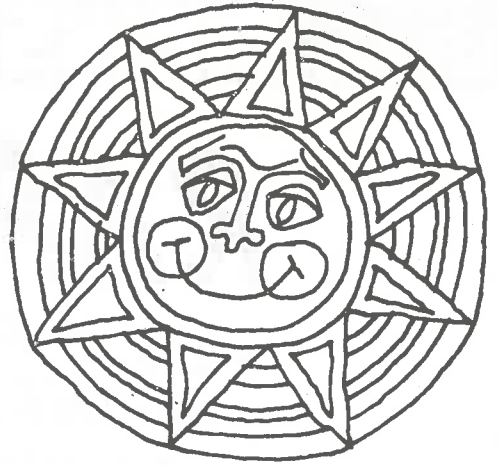

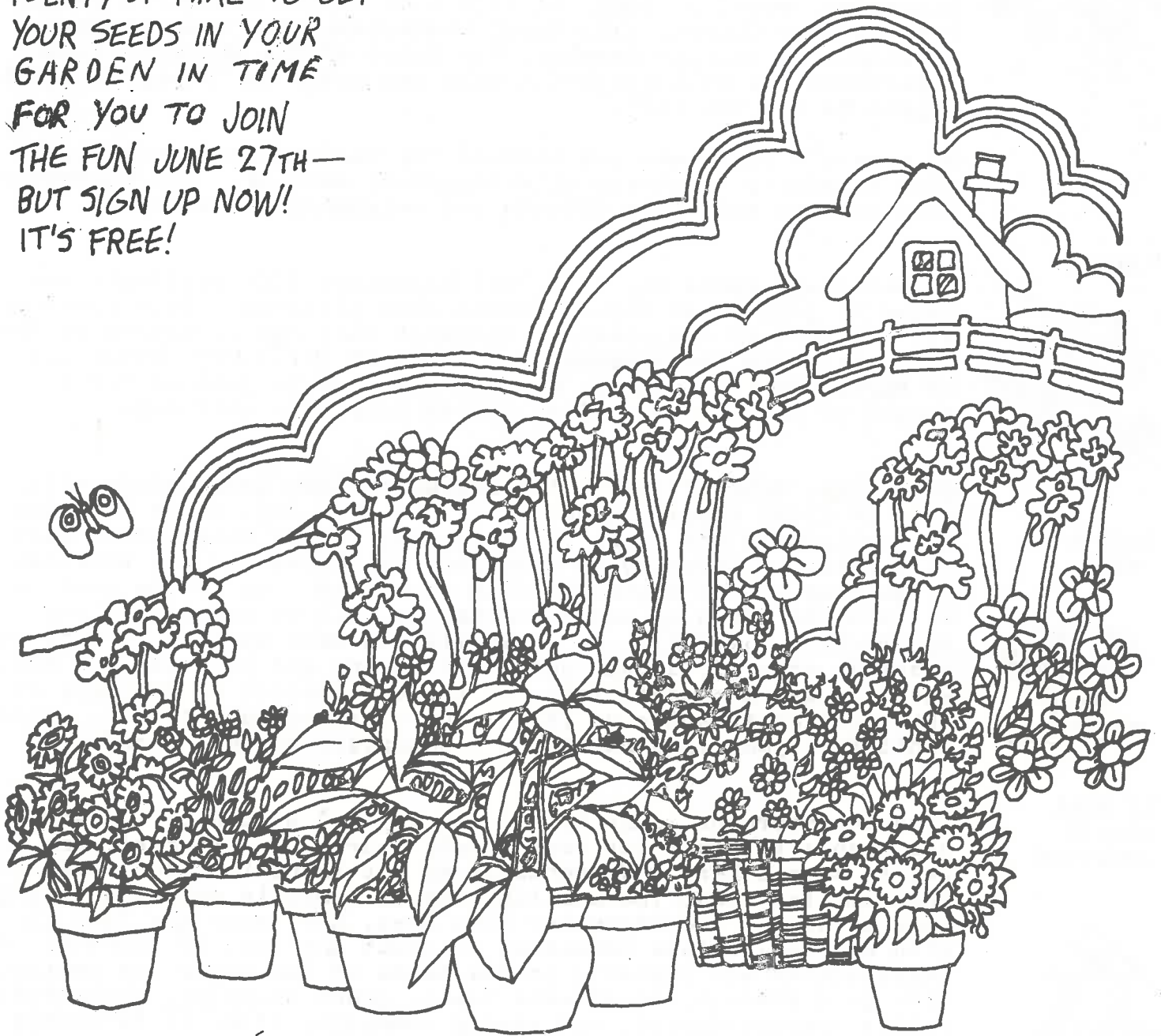
