Block Reps will be surveying their residents to determine dead and/or diseased trees and parkway areas in need of planting. Plants, fertilizer, seeds, bulbs, and topsoil will be donated by the Bureau of Forestry, the Chicago Park District, and the Botanical Gardens.



We will concentrate our main efforts on the NEBA Parkway area at Granville and Broadway, but if we have enough volunteers, we can have planting teams all over Edgewater Glen. We hope to combine our planting with a Granville-Broadway merchants' Sidewalk Sale and a Hot Dog Sale to augment our meager treasury as we usually do at the Garden Walk. Hopefully, we will involve the merchants and the Grandale Association (the Block Club immediately to our east), so that we can really make our business strip look great.



Please volunteer your services when your Block Rep comes around so that we can make this a tremendously successful effort. Next year, the event may grow to involve all of the Block Clubs in Edgewater and Rogers Park.

THEATRE

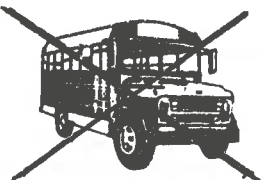

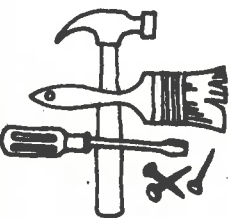
EGA REAL ESTATE COMMITTEE
