## EGA COMMUNITY MEETING

The EGA Board has had requests from Block reps for endorsement of permit parking, of traffic circles, and of pinch points, because some residents cannot find parking in front of their homes, especially late at night due to patrons of businesses on Broadway and Clark Street who park on EG streets and because the safety of residents, especially the children, is jeopardized by folks speeding down EG streets.

Both Alderman Smith and Alderman O'Connor take the position that traffic calming devices should be determined by petition.

The EGA Board takes the position that it will support each block's right to make it's own decision and recommends that each block petitions for what it wants in the way of traffic calming devices and parking solutions. the EGA Board also takes the position that permit parking may not be necessary if current parking laws are enforced.

The EGA Board also recommends and overall traffic study to determine the impact of traffic calming devices (including the proposed traffic signal at Glenlake and Broadway) on the neighborhood.

Word is that Osco Pharmacy will be going into the Del Ray Farm site. Do we want them to have a liquor license?

All EGA residents are encouraged to attend the Monday, November 23rd meeting at 7:30 PM at St Gertrudes to discuss these issues.
