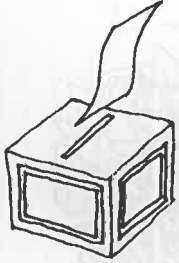

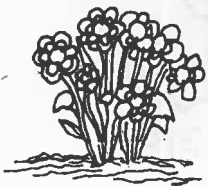
* 13TH ANNUAL EGA ELECTIONS

* 10TH ANNUAL EGA GARDEN WALK



The gardens of Edgewater Glen will be on display again on Sunday, June 24, 1984 from Noon to 5:00 p.m. when Edgewater Glen Association hosts its Tenth Annual EGA Garden Walk. On that day, those who wish to participate will open their gardens to their neighbors. This is always a great opportunity to meet your neighbors and see the lovely gardens of the Edgewater Glen community.

The format will be similar to previous events with some changes. Maps will be given at the Granville Avenue Methodist Church, 1307 W. Granville. Also, ballots for EGA's Annual Election can be obtained and marked there or later at the refreshment stand.

* 1ST ANNUAL EGA 2-MILE FUN-RUN: 1 p.m.

Beginning this year, Edgewater Glen Association will host a Two-Mile Fun Run for the residents of Edgewater Glen, starting at 1:00 p.m., June 24, 1984. The Registration Fee is \$4.00 for Adults and \$2.00 for children and will include an award of a t-shirt and a coupon for refreshments. Prizes will be awarded, but no registration is required. All pets must be accompanied by an owner under the age of 16.



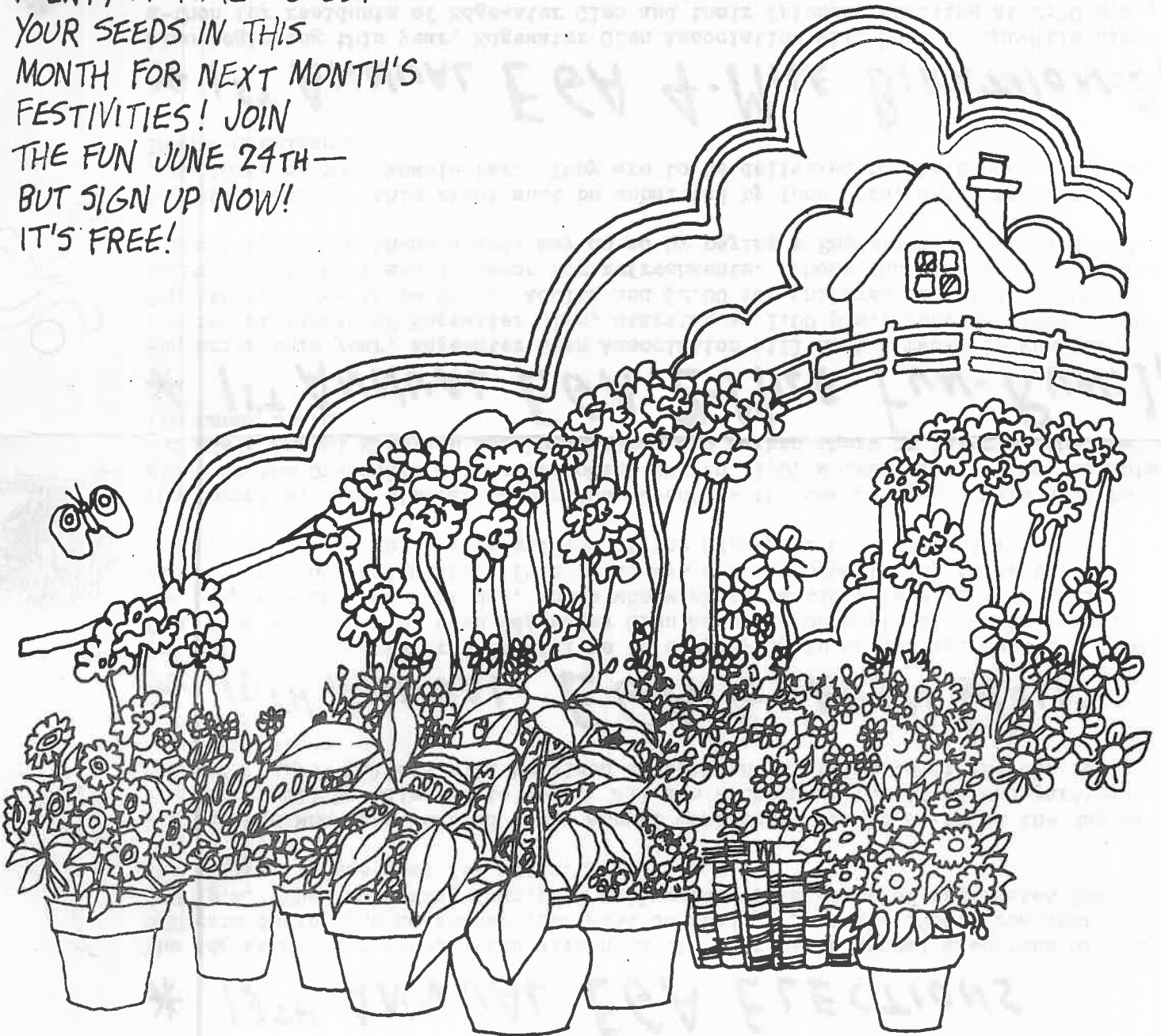

The continuing support of the residents of Edgewater Glen is essential for carrying on EGA's efforts in our community.



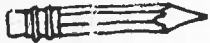
