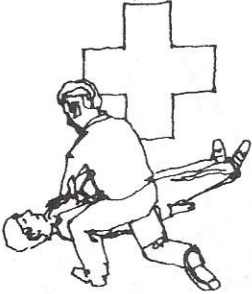

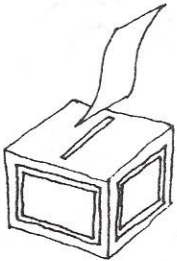

The Edgewater-Glen Association is very pleased to have an opportunity to present a special program on Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. This lifesaving technique has proven, thousands of times, to be an effective measure of saving the lives of both young and old. A City wide program is being carried out through cooperation of the Chicago Department of Health and the Chicago Heart Association to train one out of four Chicago residents in this lifesaving technique. What would you do if someone near to your collapsed with an apparent heart attack? What would you do if an accident occurred causing suffocation? Your reaction and capabilities during those critical first minutes can mean the difference between life and death, or a person being permanently disabled. Every able bodied person can learn this procedure. This presentation will be the first of its kind under the City wide program to be made to a community organization. Won't you spend just a small amount of time with your friends and neighbors to learn more about this important lifesaving program!!
