CORNER MARKERS. Last November we wrote to the Department of Public Works telling them the EGA would like to donate the markers to the City, if they would install them in the EGA boundaries and, since the City is self-insured, we would not be obligated to carry insurance on the markers. The end of July we received a letter from the Curator of Public Art for Chicago. They reviewed our proposal before the Standing Committee for Public Art, which includes reps from the Dept. of Cultural Affairs, Dept. of Public Works, Dept. of Planning, and professional arts administrators and artists. The reply included the following: "After serious consideration, our committee has recommended we decline your generous offer. The decisions of the Public Art Committee are based on established selection criteria, as well as consideration of the uniqueness of each proposal. Criteria for selection include, but are not limited to: quality, appropriateness of scale, material, form, and content; durability of work; siting possibilities; community support; maintenance and liability considerations. Because of the above considerations, we recommend you investigate alternate sites on private land."

We would appreciate any comments from EGA members. Please contact the officers or call Cathy Bisbing at 743-2121. The EGA cannot afford to carry insurance on the markers or be liable for any damages or injuries due to placement of the markers in the parkways. Together we can resolve this situation; your opinions are vital!
