Our Playlot Design

We're planning two play areas, one for toddlers and one for older children. A multi-use play structure, made of redwood, will include swings, slides, and a few unusual items as well. Wood chips were chosen as the soft-surface material.

What We Need

The Chicago Park District will contribute \$30,000 to our park, but the total cost of our current plan is \$40,000. That means we must raise at least \$10,000 by June to install our new playlot this year.
