Glenfest Needs Worker Volunteers

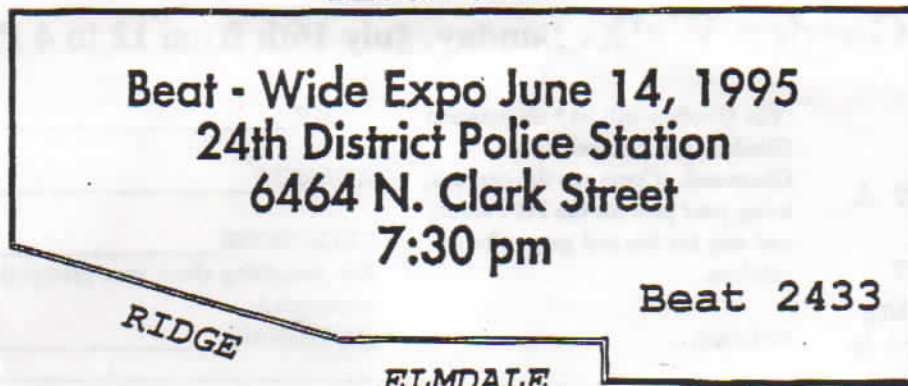
