SHOULD EGA EXPAND ITS AREA?

Recently, a group of residents on Edgewater Glen's southwest border asked if Edgewater Glen Association would expand its boundaries to include the 1400 and 1500 blocks of Elmdale and Thorndale. The reason for their request is that their area is not included in either EPIC (Broadway to Glenwood and Elmdale to Rosedale) or EGA (Broadway to Clark and Granville to Norwood). Since the area immediately south of their area is recreational (Senn Park) and the area immediately west of them is commercial, they feel their area is too small to form its own organization and too isolated from the other unorganized area south and west of them. Some of the residents have organized themselves into an Action Committee because of their concern about the large apartment building at 1448-60 W. Elmdale and the questionable efforts of the owner to maintain the building properly. But they feel their area is too small to organize into a separate organization, and so they have asked Edgewater Glen Association to accept their area into its boundaries. This question will also be discussed at our general meeting.
