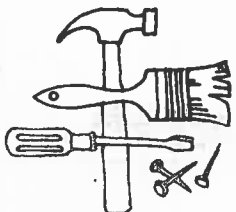

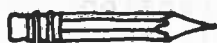
Are you a member of your community organization: EDGEWATER GLEN ASSOCIATION?
