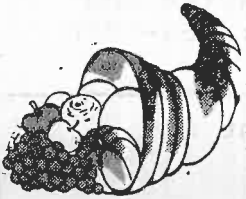
### PLANS ARE UNDERWAY FOR THE EDGEWATER GLENFEST '85:

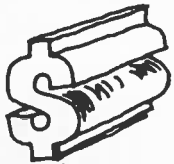
