**PRIVATE DRAIN PROGRAM/
CITY OF CHICAGO**

For the first time, the City of Chicago will take over the repair of damaged private drains (sewer lines) from the main sewer (in the middle of the street) to the homeowner's property line. This is ONLY FOR residential properties up to and including four units. Maintenance and rodding of the private drain will remain the responsibility of the homeowner.
